6. **Must have the initiative to step up and be a leader**
7. **Must be able to work in a team setting**
8. **Must have a love for the Lord, for the kids, and for camp**

COMPADRE JOB DESCRIPTION:

2. **Compadres will be responsible for teaching new songs and helping with entertainment during the week.**
